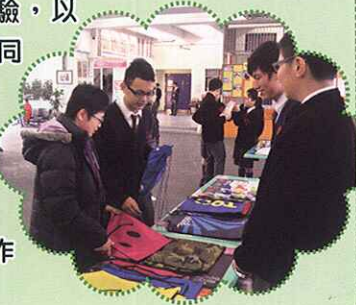

Chatteris English Fun Fair




